Hindustan Motors has today introduced an all new variant of its sedan, Mitsubishi Cedia called, Cedia Select 2012 at Rs 8.90 lakh (Ex-showroom, Delhi). The DVD player is GPS, Bluetooth and USB connectivity compatible. Rest features are all the same as the existing variant, which is priced relatively lesser than the new one, it comes at a price of Rs 8.24 Lakh (Ex-showroom, Delhi) Having equipped with the all new features, it certainly becomes more competitive now, which will help it stand against the existing players including the Honda City, Nissan Sunny, the Vento and others. Still, what might keep it behind is once again the petrol heart under the hood, as the recent sales figures have made it clear that the consumers are now moving towards the diesel variants.
