India is likely to get the Mitsubishi Lancer Evo X MR variant, which comes with a 2-litre inline-four turbocharged petrol engine. The engine is capable of pumping out 295bhp@6500rpm and 366Nm of torque. On the comfort and safety side, the car comes equipped with an auto leveling Xenon High-Intensity Discharge (HID) headlamps, Mitsubishi Multi Communication System, leather combination seat trim, heated front seats and hot shot Rockford Fosgate audio system. Due in early 2011.

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
