Hindustan Motors to launch BS IV Ambassador in August

Hindustan Motors has announced that it will soon launch the Ambassador with a BS IV compliant engine. This move will enable the company to offer the car in 17 metro markets as the government has banned the sale of BS III compliant cars here.

According to the manufacturer, the BS IV Ambassador will come with an uprated 1.5-litre diesel

engine that will produce more torque but fuel efficiency similar to the current BS III car. The Ambassador has been certified as a BS IV emissions compliant vehicle by the Automotive Research Association of India.
