


HIND MOTOR'S SCV VEER HITS THE ROAD

KOLKATA: India's pioneering car company, Hindustan Motors Ltd (HM) has launched VEER, a 0.8-ton (800 kg) small commercial vehicle here, kick-starting the company's plans to introduce more vehicles in the current financial year.

Notably, the company's chairman, C K Birla, had announced the imminent launch of a slew of new vehicles at HM's AGM held here on August 4.

"More new vehicles will follow suit. These will come both from our Uttarpara plant in West Bengal, where we manufacture the iconic Ambassador, and our Chennai facility, where we build the Mitsubishi range of vehicles," said Manoj Jha, the company's MD, after unveiling the new vehicle.
